Whereupon the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

MINUTES READ AND APPROVED: The minutes of December 17 & 18, 2001, were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the minutes of December 17 & 18, 2001, as read and corrected. It was seconded and carried.

CLAIMS: The claims presented were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the claims presented. It was seconded and carried.

CRAIG HOOPER - PROPERTY TAX HARDSHIP CANCELLATION: Craig Hooper met with the Board to ask for cancellation of his 1999 and 2000 property taxes. After going over Craig's financial status and the possibility of getting on Social Security Disability, and noting that there would not be a tax deed against his property for another year, a motion was made to not approve a hardship cancellation of his 1999 and 2000 property taxes. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR WORK ORDER FORMS: Dennis Thayer, Maintenance Supervisor, met to develop a work order form for maintenance work that the different departments request. The orders will be filled out by Department heads and turned in to the Commissioners, who will then prioritize them and give them to Dennis.

NOXIOUS WEED DEPARTMENT PRICE LIST: Jake Wyant from the Noxious

Weed Department met with a price list for supplies and repairs, which were approved for the lowest costs.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE: A motion was made to approve alcoholic beverage licenses for: Jacob A. Jensen, Jr., doing business as Letha Store for bottled or canned beer not to be consumed on premises and retail wine; David and Clitana Elsberry/K & K Industries doing business as Don's Market for bottled or canned beer to be consumed on premises and retail wine; Alice Morelli doing business as Tom's Cabin for draught and bottled or canned beer.

INDIGENT APPLICATIONS: A motion was made, seconded, and carried to go into executive session under Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(d). Clerk Susan Howard presented the following indigent applications:

99-011 Application needed a release of lien signed because the account was paid off.

02-020 Application was presented only and needed a statutory lien signed.

02-021 Application for a rent deposit of \$250.

02-022 Application for rent assistance of \$800.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried to come out of executive session.

A motion was made to sign the release of lien on 99-011, to sign the statutory lien on 02-020, to deny 02-021 because no emergency existed and a social security check is expected, to deny 02-022 because no emergency existed because applicant is moving in with mother, and to change the decision on a previous denial of 01-057 to pay December 2001 and January 2002 rent of \$390/mo on a one-time-only basis because of extenuating circumstances. It was seconded and carried.
