MINUTES READ AND APPROVED: The minutes of May 20 & 21, 2002, were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the minutes of May 20 & 21, 2002, as read and corrected. It was seconded and carried.

BILL BROWN APPOINTED TO SOUTHWEST DISTRICT BOARD OF HEALTH:

A motion was made to confirm the appointment of Bill Brown, Commissioner of Adams County, to the Southwest District Board of Health. It was seconded and carried.

OLA FIRE STATION CONTRACT: A motion was made to sign the Idaho Community Development Block Grant Program Contract No. ICDBG-02-III-5-PF with the Department of Commerce for the Gem County/Ola Fire Station. It was seconded and carried.

CHRIS HANAU - BID ON PEARL PROPERTY TAX DEED: Chris Hanau, Ada County resident, met to put a bid on the tax deeded property Parcel RP 00193400, Sec 15 & 16 6N 1E in Pearl of \$1,410. The property assessed at \$1,410 for the 39.9 acres, with \$312.73 taxes and fees due. The property is possibly landlocked. A motion was made to accept Chris Hanau's bid of \$1,410. It was seconded and carried.
