- \$400 Education:**
- Purchase new “Idaho’s Noxious Weeds” booklets for handout to the public – Weed Department 50/50. Furnish Elwood Elk and Marty Milfoil DVDs to Elementary and Middle Schools.
- \$7000 Landowner Cost-Share:**
- Provide educational material and herbicide to landowner to treat their land for any noxious weeds.
- \$2000 City of Emmett: Puncturevine**
- Provide herbicide to the City. They will hire applicator.
- \$850 Railroad Right-of-Way:**
- Provide herbicide to the local RR. They will do the applications.
- \$1075 Bissel Creek-Rush Skeletonweed:**
- Provide herbicide to treat rangeland buffer strip between BLM property and private ranch. BLM will contract to have their property treated and herbicide comparison plots will be demonstrated. GCWC will do the herbicide applications, and the Rush Skeletonweed Task Force will monitor and host tours.
- \$1850 Drain Ditch Parrotfeather:**
- Provide herbicide to treat drains and a pond near the Payette River for Parrotfeather Milfoil.
- \$7150 Capital Equipment:**
- Purchase of a Polaris Ranger and equipment to build a spray rig. Weed Department 50/50. To be put together by Gem County Weed Control for use in 2010.
